Amendment #3 to RFP: SJPC-CBRP6519 – Questions from Potential Bidders

- Q1. Are you open to receiving quotes on late Model Year 2016 and Above Used (Reconditioned) with low hours for the 10,000lb and 15,000lb forklifts?
- A1. Quotes on used/reconditioned forklifts cannot be accepted.
- Q2. Do you require Diesel forklifts on the 10,000lb and 15,000lb forklifts? Are you open to Liquid Propane?
- A2. All forklifts are required to have Tier 4 engines.
- Q3. Are you flexible on the lowered mast specifications on the BID, as long as the forklift will fit through your lowered door heights and reach max fork height requirements?
- A3. 55k and 36k lifts are flexible on mast specifications within 12 inches. 15k lifts are flexible within 12 inches and, if needed, a 3-stage mast 100 inches lowered. 10k lifts need to be under 107 inches with 48 inches of free lift.
- Q4. 96" forks are standard on the 55,000lb and 36,000lb forklifts. Are you okay with that fork length?
- A4. Yes, that fork length is acceptable.
- Q5. 48" forks are normal standards on the 10,000lb and 15,000lb forklifts. Does that work, instead of the 50" fork length that is on the BID requirements?
- A5. Yes, that fork length is acceptable.
- Q6. What Stage Mast do you need on the 10,000lb forklifts?
- A6. A 3-Stage mast is required.
- Q7. What Stage Mast do you need on the 15,000lb forklifts?
- A7. A 2 or 3-Stage mast is required.
