

Amendment #1 to RFP: SJPC-PPC-06192020 – Questions from Potential Bidders

Q1: Will SJPC considering waiving the notary requirement on the non-collusion affidavit and debarred list affidavit in light of the current COVID environment?

A1: SJPC will not waive the notary requirement of the RFP.

Q2: Will SJPC consider accepting electronic submission in lieu of the required five hard copies?

A2: Although hard copies of the proposal are preferred, SJPC will accept electronic submissions.

Q3: Will SJPC consider extending the proposal deadline, given the request for question deadline is 6/15 which would only leave four business days to address any revisions/concerns raised in the questions.

A3: The proposal deadline will not be extended.

Q4: Does SJPC anticipate selecting one or multiple consultants?

A4: SJPC will select multiple firms to become part of a prequalified list of Port Planning Consultants.

Q5: Would SJPC consider altering the indemnification clause of the RFP?

A5: SJPC will not alter the RFP's indemnification clause.
