

**Addendum #1 to SJPC-22-21 (Maintenance Dredging): August 8, 2022**

**Questions from Potential Bidders:**

Q1: During the pre-bid meeting, it was mentioned that this job is “offshore”. Does this mean that the disposal site has been switched from White’s Basin to an offshore dumpsite? If so, please provide location of dumpsite and permit information.

A1: The job is located in the Delaware River. Dredging area is as shown on the plans. There is no offshore; ie Atlantic Ocean or Delaware Bay component to the project that would be considered “offshore.”

Q2: The Army Corps permit identifies Biles island as a potential disposal location. Is the material permitted for disposal at Biles Island? If so, please provide the relevant permit documents.

A2: The permit will allow for disposal at Whites Basin or Biles island locations. See previous example permit in Bid documents. New permit will have same disposal options

Q3: What is the schedule for completion of this work?

A3: Work should be completed within 90 days of Notice to Proceed.

Q4: Appendices A and B in the Technical Specifications refer to an email attachment that is not present in that document. Please provide these Appendixes.

Q5: The specifications call out payment on a “scow count” basis. Does this mean that final payment will not be based on a calculated volume using before and after hydrographic surveys? What is the methodology for determining the “scow count” volume?

A5: This is incorrect. Payment will be based upon the SJPC before and after surveys.
