A. <u>RESOLUTION 2022-08-0092: APPROVAL TO PURCHASE</u> <u>MODULAR RESTROOMS AT THE BALZANO MARINE</u> <u>TERMINAL, CAMDEN NJ</u>

REQUEST

Approval is requested to purchase a modular restroom structure to replace the existing unit located in Shed 2 at the Balzano Terminal, Camden, NJ.

BACKGROUND

The existing men / women's modular unit in Shed 2 is deteriorated and requires frequent repairs to maintain operating toilets and sinks. These restroom facilities are used by port field personnel as well as materials transport truckers.

SJPC staff has prepared the design criteria and engaged the services of Boxx Modular, a manufacturer of modular buildings, for a pricing proposal and preliminary floor plan design. The removal of the existing restrooms and installation of the new unit will be performed by SJPC maintenance staff. Boxx Modular will manufacturer and deliver the modular unit to the port.

We have received a quotation from Boxx Modular for this project through the TIPS National Cooperative Purchase contract #200902 (SJPC member number 966276) in the amount of \$ 85,508.00. Funds are being provided through the 2017A Capital Projects account.

RECOMMENDATION

Staff is therefore recommending Board Approval to purchase replacement restrooms at the Balzano Marine Terminal for the amount of \$ 85,508.00.

RESOLUTION 2022-08-0093: APPROVAL TO EXECUTE ONE-YEAR RENEWAL OPTION FOR TRASH REMOVAL CONTRACT AT BALZANO AND BROADWAY MARINE TERMINALS

REQUEST

Staff is requesting Board approval to execute the option to extend the existing Trash Removal Contract for the first of the two additional one-year options with Green Guys Recycling in Deptford, NJ. This contract extension will be for one year starting October 1, 2022.

BACKGROUND

Pursuant to RESOLUTION 2021-08-0081 TRASH REMOVAL CONTRACT, Green Guys Recycling of Deptford, NJ, was awarded the contract on September 16, 2021 for trash removal at the Balzano and Broadway Marine Terminals. The contractor has been performing trash removal at for a one-year period. The contract included two one-year options to extend the trash removal services at the discretion of the SJPC. Based on their good performance, staff are recommending that the first of the two one-year renewal options be executed at this time. Estimated volumes are twenty-five to forty, 30 or 40 cubic yard containers per month, and up to three cubic yard containers to be emptied twice per week. Rates proposed in the initial bid proposal remain the same in the renewal period.

RECOMMENDATION

C. <u>RESOLUTION 2022-08-0094: APPROVAL TO ISSUE AN</u> <u>RFP FOR DESIGN SERVICES TO EXTEND RAIL TRACK</u> <u>AT BROADWAY MARINE TERMINAL</u>

REQUEST

Staff is requesting Board approval to issue an RFP to the list of prequalified civil engineering firms to perform design services to extend the existing rail track at the Broadway Marine Terminal in Camden, NJ.

BACKGROUND

South Jersey Port Corporation has been awarded a grant of \$1,108,254.17 from the New Jersey Department of Transportation's (NJDOT's) FY 2022 Rail Freight Assistance Program (RFAP) for the Port's "Rail Integration Project." The grant will enable SJPC to purchase an electric rail car mover, two mobile rail loading docks, and extend the existing rail at the Broadway Marine Terminal. The scope of track work includes design for installation of approximately 300' of new rail, adjacent pavement restoration, and installation of the end of rail track bumper.

This RFP is for engineering design of the rail extension portion of the project.

RECOMMENDATION

Staff recommends Board approval to issue a request for proposals to perform design services for the extension of rail track at the Broadway Marine Terminal.



D. <u>RESOLUTION 2022-08-0095: APPROVAL TO AWARD A</u> <u>CONSTRUCTION CONTRACT FOR THE</u> <u>PERFORMANCE OF MAINTENANCE DREDGING AT</u> <u>THE BALZANO AND BROADWAY MARINE TERMINALS</u>

REQUEST

Pursuant to the Board Authorization: RESOLUTION 2022-02-0021 APPROVAL TO ADVERTISE CONSTRUCTION BIDS FOR MAINTENANCE DREDGING AT BALZANO AND BROADWAY TERMINALS, an Invitation for Bidders was advertised for the solicitation of public bids to perform maintenance dredging and disposal of the dredged material.

BACKGROUND

Dredging was last completed at the Port of Camden marine terminals in January of 2019, and since then, gradual sedimentation has resulted in the need for dredging which is becoming critical for the berthing of the approximately 140 ships which visit the terminals each year.

Accordingly, soundings were performed in January 2022, and it was determined that a total of approximately 65,000 cy of material will be removed from the two marine terminals and disposed of at an upland facility.

A pre-bid meeting was held on August 3, 2022, with four (4) contractors in attendance. The bids were received on August 18, 2022. A single bid was received from Weeks Marine, Inc., from Covington, LA, with a local office in Camden, NJ, in the amount of \$ 3,167,270.00.

RECOMMENDATION

Staff is recommending Board approval to award a construction contract for maintenance dredging of the Balzano and Broadway Terminals in Camden to Weeks Marine, Inc. in the Lump Sum Bid Amount of \$ 3,167,270.00.



E. <u>RESOLUTION 2022-08-0096: APPROVAL TO IMPLEMENT</u> <u>A STORAGE CONGESTION FEE ON IMPORTED</u> <u>PLYWOOD AND STEEL</u>

REQUEST

Staff is requesting Board approval to implement a storage congestion fee on imported plywood and steel coils in order to encourage warehouse inventory turnover at SJPC's Broadway and Balzano Terminals.

BACKGROUND

SJPC's Camden terminals are two of the primary marine gateways in the US for imported plywood and steel coils and have an excellent reputation for efficient handling and warehousing these commodities, which are sensitive to the elements and require indoor storage. SJPC is continuing to experience strong demand for accepting plywood and steel ships, but largely due to SJPC's comparatively very liberal tariff storage escalation rates, many plywood crates and steel coils tend to sit in the terminal warehouses longer than should be expected before the importers arrange truck pickups for delivery to manufacturing and construction sites. This situation causes SJPC to delay additional ship calls due to lack of warehouse capacity, which combined with low storage rates, causes SJPC to lose potential revenue. SJPC has reviewed storage fees at several competitive ports, which definitely supports monthly escalations to a storage fee of approximately \$0.88 per 100 lbs. per month for plywood and \$0.74 per 100 lbs. for steel, at the 4-month threshold, with incremental escalations thereafter. Upon board approval, staff's intent would be to append this congestion fee to the Camden Terminal Tariff 300 as soon as possible, to remain in place through the end of 2022, at which point SJPC would anticipate including a general storage rate tariff update as part of a comprehensive update to SJPC's Camden Terminal Tariff 300.

F. <u>RESOLUTION 2022-08-0097: APPROVAL FOR</u> <u>EXECUTIONS OF MEMORANDA OF SUBLEASE AND</u> <u>TERMINATIONS OF MEMORANDA OF SUBLEASE AT</u> <u>PAULSBORO</u>

REQUEST

Staff is requesting Board approval to approve executions of Memoranda of Sublease and Terminations of Memoranda of Sublease at Paulsboro.

BACKGROUND

EEW American Offshore Structures is currently subleasing a portion of the Paulsboro Marine Terminal, on which they are constructing a monopile manufacturing facility for New Jersey's offshore wind turbine installations. In order to obtain financing to complete the monopile manufacturing facility, EEW is requesting memoranda of leases from each lease party for the sequence of leases in place at Paulsboro as a requirement for recording purposes to satisfy EEW's lender title company requirements. In order to assist this effort, SJPC would execute a Memorandum of Sublease for each of the Paulsboro sublease agreements it is a party to, which is then recorded against title. In addition to executing each Memorandum of Sublease, Conflict Counsel is also recommending execution of a corresponding Termination of Memorandum of Sublease, to be held in escrow for expediency purposes in the event of termination of any of the leases, so that title can be cleared without issue. The specific documents for which a Memorandum of Sublease and a Termination of Memorandum of Sublease are being requested are the following:

- January 16, 2006 Lease between Borough of Paulsboro and SJPC
- August 1, 2009 Port Essex Project Site Ground Lease, as amended, between Borough of Paulsboro and SJPC
- November 6, 2014 Paulsboro Marine Terminal Lease between SJPC and Camden Waterfront Development, as assigned to Paulsboro Waterfront Development, and as amended

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Counsel would review each Memorandum of Sublease and Termination of Memorandum of Sublease prior to execution.

RECOMMENDATION

Staff therefore requests Board approval to approve executions of Memoranda of Sublease and Terminations of Memoranda of Sublease at Paulsboro.



G. <u>RESOLUTION 2022-08-0098: APPROVAL FOR</u> <u>EXECUTION OF CONSENT TO AMENDMENT TO</u> <u>PAULSBORO MARINE TERMINAL SUBLEASE</u>

REQUEST

Staff is requesting Board approval to authorize SJPC'S Executive Director and CEO to execute a Consent to an Amendment of the Sublease between Paulsboro Waterfront Development and EEW American Offshore Structures, subject to Legal Counsel review.

BACKGROUND

On January 11, 2021, SJPC's Executive Director and CEO executed a Consent to Sublease with Paulsboro Waterfront Development (PWD) as Sublandlord, and EEW American Offshore Structures (EEW) as Subtenant, wherein PWD subleased approximately 70 acres of the Paulsboro Marine Terminal (PMT) to EEW for construction of its monopile manufacturing facility. The sublease provided for temporary use of a portion of PWD premises until such time as the Clorox site was ready for occupancy and use by EEW, at which time an amendment to the sublease would be executed to commemorate the addition of the Clorox site to the EEW sublease premises and the return of the other acreage to PWD's premises. In anticipation of PWD and EEW executing this amendment to the sublease, SJPC should be prepared to execute a consent to the sublease amendment.

RECOMMENDATION

Staff is therefore requesting Board approval to authorize SJPC'S Executive Director and CEO to execute a Consent to an Amendment of the Sublease between Paulsboro Waterfront Development and EEW American Offshore Structures, subject to Legal Counsel review.
