A. <u>RESOLUTION 2024-11-0139: APPROVAL TO AWARD A</u> <u>CONSTRUCTION CONTRACT FOR EXTENSION OF THE</u> <u>FIRE MAIN AT PIER 5 AT THE BROADWAY MARINE</u> <u>TERMINAL</u>

REQUEST

Staff is requesting Board approval to award a construction contract for extension of the fire main to Warehouse 3 at Pier 5 of the Broadway Marine Terminal.

BACKGROUND

As reported in the October 29, 2024, Board meeting Executive Director's report, underground pipe breaks on September 16, September 28, and October 2, required abandonment of the 8" fire main which served Warehouse 3 at Pier 5. Warehouse 3 is still out of service and has been on fire watch since then.

In order to restore service, a 280-foot-long extension of the fire main will be constructed. This new pipe will become a permanent part of the loop system for Pier 5, and included in the overall Underground Fire Main Replacement project at the Broadway Marine Terminal.

That larger project is mandated under a December 2017 administrative consent order with the New Jersey Department of Community Affairs, Bureau of Fire Safety, and is funded with a New Jersey state grant issued in 2022. The design was prepared by Remington and Vernick Engineers of Cherry Hill, NJ, pursuant to SJPC Board Resolution 2023-06-0050.

The bid documents were advertised in three newspapers and posted on the SJPC website. In addition, ten (10) prospective bidders were notified directly of the opportunity. The pre-bid walkthrough was performed on October 18th, and the bids were opened on November 1st, 2024.

Three (3) bids were received as follows:

Staff is therefore requesting Board approval to award a construction contract for extension of the fire main at Pier 5 of the Broadway Marine Terminal to the low bidder, Richard E. Pierson Construction Company, Woodstown, NJ, in the lump sum not to exceed amount of \$ 170,400.00.

D. <u>RESOLUTION 2024-11-0142: APPROVAL OF NON-</u> <u>REPRESENTED STAFF COMPENSATION</u> <u>ADJUSTMENTS</u>

REQUEST

Staff is requesting Board approval for an annual compensation adjustment, in line with current SJPC Collective Bargaining Agreements (CBA), for non-represented staff.

BACKGROUND

In concert with all of the Collective Bargaining Agreements (CBA) in effect at the South Jersey Port Corporation, staff requests Board consideration and approval of a 3.5% compensation adjustment for all non-represented employees effective January 1, 2025.

This includes the Executive Director and CEO, Assistant Executive Director/COO, Assistant Executive Director/Chief Commercial Officer, Chief of Staff and External Affairs, Director of Engineering, CFO/Treasurer, Director of Legal and Regulatory Affairs, Facilities Engineer, General Manager Security, Public Safety, and Emergency Management, Senior Executive Assistant, Senior Advisor – Administration, Senior Advisor – Engineering, HR Manager, and Janitor.

RECOMMENDATION:

Staff recommends Board approval of the non-represented staff compensation adjustment recommendation.



E. <u>RESOLUTION 2024-11-0143: APPROVAL TO EXECUTE</u> <u>THE 2025 PILOT AGREEMENTS WITH THE COUNTY OF</u> <u>CAMDEN, THE CITY OF SALEM, AND THE CITY OF</u> <u>CAMDEN</u>

REQUEST

Staff is requesting Board approval to execute the South Jersey Port Corporation ("SJPC") Pilot Agreements for calendar year 2025 with the County of Camden, the City of Salem, and the City of Camden.

BACKGROUND

1. The County of Camden 2025 calendar year Pilot Agreement's terms and conditions are the same as 2024's agreement. The 2025 Pilot payment is in the same amount as 2024's Pilot payment -- \$419,000.00.

2. The City of Salem 2025 calendar year Pilot Agreement's terms and conditions are the same as 2024's agreement. The 2025 Pilot payment is in the same amount as 2024's Pilot payment -- \$31,225.37.

3. The City of Camden 2025 calendar year Pilot Agreement's terms and conditions are the same as 2024's agreement. The 2025 Pilot payment is in the same amount as last year's Pilot payment -- \$4,000,000.00.

RECOMMENDATION

Staff recommends Board approval to execute the SJPC's Pilot Agreements for calendar year 2025 with the County of Camden, the City of Salem, and the City of Camden.

- Pending, ongoing or anticipated litigation or contract negotiation, including attorney-client privilege. The threat of litigation must be more than theoretical for this exemption to apply.
- Personnel matters affecting employees of the public bodies, unless all parties request or consent to a public hearing. Prior to discussion of personnel, affected employees must be given notice, known as a Rice notice, which gives the employee the right to request a public hearing.
- Proceedings that could result in a suspension, civil penalty, or loss of a license or permit.
